Mid-level Practitioner Skills Protocols After consideration of a request from James E. Johnson, M.D., for reconsideration of the initial certification requirements and annual maintenance of certification requirements regarding the placement of central venous lines, internal jugular; central venous lines, femoral; radial arterial lines; and femoral arterial lines, the Credentials Committee recommended that the Board's previous decision of March 20, 2013, which states, *....in allowing for the overlapping skills required for placement of central venous lines, internal jugular; central venous lines, femoral; radial arterial lines; and femoral arterial lines, the initial certification and maintenance of certification requirements be modified to require a combined overall total of 50 procedures for initial certification in all four procedures, and a combined overall total of 20 procedures per year for maintenance of certification in all four procedures. The Committee recommended that the documentation of training, to be submitted for Board approval, include a documented physician supervised performance of at least one of each procedure.*, be reaffirmed with the provision that 50% of the total procedures required for initial certification and annual maintenance certification are permitted to be performed in the simulation lab with the

understanding that it is the Board's preference that 100% of the maintenance of certification procedures be obtained through the performance of live procedures. The Committee recommended that the documentation of training should clearly identify lab and live procedures. The motion was adopted without objection.

The Committee recommended that a mid-level practitioner who performs placement of only one of the following: central venous line, internal jugular; central venous line, femoral; radial arterial line; or femoral arterial line, be required to perform 20 documented procedures for initial certification and 10 documented procedures for annual maintenance certification with the provision that 50% of the total procedures are permitted to be performed in the simulation lab with the stipulation that it is the Board's preference that 100% of the maintenance of certification procedures be obtained through the performance of live procedures. The Committee recommended that the documentation of training should clearly identify lab and live procedures. The motion was adopted without objection.

The Committee recommended that the mid-level practitioner *Middle Level Skills Protocol* be amended to reflect these changes for vascular access procedures only. The motion was adopted without objection.




