<u>Administrative Rules for Final Adoption</u>

Administrative Rule 540-X-7-.30, Physician Assistants' Advisory Committee The Credentials Committee recommended that Administrative Rule 540-X-7-.30, Physician Assistants' Advisory Committee, be approved for final adoption. The motion was adopted without objection.

Administrative Rules for Publication

Administrative Rule 540-X-26-.05, Limitations (Pharmacy Collaboration) The Credentials Committee recommended that Administrative Rule 540-X-26.05, *Limitations*, be published for public comment in the *Alabama Administrative Monthly*. The motion was adopted without objection.

<u>License Requirement for B Readers</u> After consideration of a request for a Board opinion concerning the licensure requirement for a physician providing B Reader services for patients in Alabama, the Credentials Committee recommended Dr. Ropp be notified that an Alabama medical license would be required. The motion was adopted without objection.

<u>Thrive Clinical Consulting – IV Hydration and Wellness Clinics</u> The Credentials Committee recommended this item be received as information.

Reporting of Adverse Events The Credentials Committee recommended that, concerning rules pertaining to the use of lasers and other modalities affecting living tissue, an amendment that expands the adverse event reporting requirement to include lesser injuries than 3rd degree burns be drafted for Board consideration. The motion was adopted without objection.

Request for Declaratory Ruling by Board of Pharmacy The Credentials Committee recommended that, regarding GLP-1 products, the Board's General Counsel be approved to draft a Declaratory Ruling opining that 1) physicians are not permitted to compound or dispense a drug using non-prescription quality ingredients; 2) physicians are required to purchase prescription products or ingredients only from an entity permitted by the Alabama Board of Pharmacy; and 3) physicians are required to comply with USP standards when compounding GLP-1 products. The motion was adopted without objection. A copy of the Declaratory Ruling shall be made a part of these Minutes and shall be attached hereto as Exhibit A.
