With prior notice given in accordance with the Alabama Open Meetings Act, and with a quorum of the Board physically present, Board Chairman Charles M. A. Rogers, IV, M.D., convened the public portion of the meeting of the Alabama State Board of Medical Examiners.

Executive Director's Report Director Perkins provided information regarding a virtual training class for new Board members offered by the Federation of State Medical Boards then called on Matt Hart to provide a report regarding the collaborative and supervisory practice continuing medical education courses offered by the Alabama Board of Medical Examiners to physicians and physician assistants now available online. Mr. Hart shared that the Sunset Audit Report is scheduled to be released August 19, 2024, and invited Board members to attend the Sunset Hearing to be held on September 26, 2024.

Public Minutes of July 18, 2024 The Credentials Committee recommended that the Public Minutes of July 18, 2024, be approved. The motion was adopted without objection.

CURRENT BUSINESS

Administrative Rules for Final Adoption

Administrative Rules 540-X-7-.29 (P.A.), 540-X-7-.62 (A.A.), and 540-X-14-.02 (M.D./D.O.)

Continuing Medical Education – Professional Boundaries Course The Credentials Committee

recommended Administrative Rule 540-X-7-.29, *Continuing Medical Education – Physician Assistant (P.A.)*, Administrative Rule 540-X-7-.62, *Continuing Medical Education – Anesthesiologist Assistant (A.A.)*, and Administrative Rule 540-X-14-.02, *Basic Requirement*, be approved for final adoption with the non-substantive amendment to delete the words “two credit” from where they appear in the documents. The motion was adopted without objection.

#### Administrative Rules for Publication

Administrative Rule 540-X-7-.08, Grandfather Clause – Physician Assistant (P.A.) The Credentials Committee recommended Administrative Rule 540-X-7-.08, *Grandfather Clause*, be amended and be republished for public comment in the *Alabama Administrative Monthly*. The motion was adopted without objection.

#### Other

Telemedicine Services Provided to Addiction and Mental Health Patients After consideration of a request for a Board opinion, the Credentials Committee recommended that, pending the drafting and adoption of telemedicine rules, and limited to the facts stated in the request, the Board issue an informal opinion that a subsequent prescriber, of the same or similar specialty as a previous prescriber in the same practice or physician group, may continue to prescribe a controlled substance to a patient based upon an “in-person” examination by the previous prescriber.

The Credentials Committee recommended that legal staff be approved to draft telemedicine rules for Board consideration. The motion was adopted without objection.

Administrative Rules, Chapter 540-X-10, Office Based Surgery The Credentials Committee recommended the proposed amended Administrative Rules, Chapter 540-X-10, *Office Based*

*Surgery*, be deferred for further review by the full Board. The motion was adopted without objection.




